

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Since Metrolina Christian Academy seeks to instill a sense of commitment to serving others, students in grades 9 through 12 are required to complete community service hours each year. These community service hours will be tracked and reported through their Bible classes by the third quarter using the Community Service Documentation Form. This form can also be found on the MCA website under Academics/Upper School/Warrior Service Program. The following are the number of hours required for each grade level:

2023-24 Academic Year
Freshman: 16 hours
Sophomores: 20 hours
Juniors: 24 hours
Seniors: 28 hours

Other information regarding earning community service hours:

- All mission trip participants receive half (½) credit toward the hourly service (ex: Freshman can receive 8 hours for a mission trip, Sophomores can receive 10, etc.).
- School clubs and organizations may conduct service projects in which students may receive credit for that club and for the service program.
- Students may participate in service projects for their church or for any nonprofit organization.
- Supervisors' names and phone numbers are required on the documentation
