## 2020-21 MODIFIED OPERATIONS PLAN - LUNCH

As we begin the 2020-21 school, Metrolina Christian Academy's cafeteria, the Metro Station, will operate under a modified food service plan. Our goal is the overall health and safety of our students, staff and families. We will continue to monitor and adapt our policies/plans as necessary.

Food Service staff to follow new health screening and PPE protocol along with enhanced cleaning and disinfection of kitchen area, cooking utensils, equipment and cafeteria.

The process and location for dining will be changed in each Division to reduce the number of students gathering in the cafeteria and other locations. Reconfigured cafeteria seating with fewer students per table and outdoor seating for all Divisions when weather permits.

Separate cafeteria entry and exit points for students and staff.

Multiple food service lines to allow for social distancing.

All lunch items (entrée, beverage, side item, dessert) must be <u>pre-ordered</u>. <u>Watch tutorial</u> <u>video</u> on how to submit lunch order for your student(s). Click <u>here</u> for menu options for Pre-Ordered Lunch. Menu designed so you can 'build your own lunch' to include the entrée, beverage, side item and dessert of your choice.

A limited Grab-n-Go menu will be available for pre-order only. (Important Change: There will be no Grab-N-Go purchases available during lunch periods or morning breaks.)

All food items, including disposable utensils, will be pre-packaged or individually wrapped.

There will be no self-service of food or beverage.

Microwaves will not be available for use.

Individual food/lunch deliveries for students will not be permitted.

Since there will be no visitors allowed in the classrooms or the cafeteria during lunch, MCA will offer a birthday package for parents to purchase for their child to celebrate his/her birthday with their classmates during lunch. Your Grab-N-Go account will be charged for your birthday package.
