Metrolina Christian Academy allows prospective students to schedule time to shadow another student for consideration of enrollment into the Academy. This visit must be pre-arranged through the MCA Admissions Office by a parent in advance. Host requests are accepted but cannot be guaranteed.

Students desiring to shadow must meet the following conditions and complete the bottom portion of this form:

- All student visitors for shadowing purposes must be pre-arranged through the MCA Admissions Office. This allows time to notify teachers, office personnel, and to set up the process with the individual student that will be the host.
- Biblical principles are integrated into every subject taught at our school. Our staff is committed not only to academic excellence, but also to teaching students how to apply the truths of God's Word to every aspect of life. If you agree with the teachings of God's Word, this school will complement the beliefs and ideals your child is taught at home.
- Students that are shadowing must comply with the MCA dress code and discipline code. If you have questions about this, please contact the MCA Admissions Department. Cell phones must remain off during school hours.
- Visitors must be in good standing at their current school (no discipline issues within the past year) and must be considering admission to MCA.
- Student visitors are required to bring their lunch, their Bible, a notebook, a book to read (in case they are taking a test in one of the classes), and something to write with. Backpacks are encouraged. Students are not required to do the work but are encouraged to participate.
- A parent must accompany the student on the morning of the visit, bringing them to the appropriate office. The parent will sign the student in through our Visitor's Log.
- An MCA student host will meet the student visitor in the office, be responsible for taking the student to the classroom(s), making introductions, giving information, and bringing the student back to the office at the end of the pre-determined time.
